Enhancements

Release 4.0 PTF 9604:

- + JCL Files (AS/400 to MVS only). The XSAM, XVSAM, and XPDS commands allow the user to specify files containing JCL cards, which will be inserted into the submitted job stream. A pre and post JCL file can be specified.
- + UNIT(*NONE) (AS/400 to MVS only). The XSAM and XPDS commands, UNIT(*NONE) can be specified. No UNIT parameter will be built on the host system DD card.
- + Sync file, no unit restriction. The file BDS.XFER.SYNC no longer must reside on UNIT=SYSDA.
- + Work files, unit specification other than SYSDA allowed. The administrator can specify a UNIT parameter on the BFXOPTS module, which will apply to all work files FileXfer creates.
- + User exit programs, COBOL source provided. The administrator can user the COBOL or Assembler source in BDS.XFER.DATALIB when writing exit programs.

Installation Instructions

WARNINGS:

1. The update may overlay any changes made to **BDS** objects by the user (XFEXIT01, BRS370). The user may need to reapply any changes made to **BDS** supplied objects after applying the update.

Note: The supplied tape contains the entire FileXfer package. If you are installing FileXfer for the first time, follow the instructions in Chapter 2, "Installation". Otherwise, use the instructions below to update your FileXfer to the latest version.

MVS:

1 .Create **JCL** needed to load FileXfer. Note: File 5 on the supplied **BDS** tape, label **BDS.XFER.INSTJCL** contains sample **JCL** to assist you. The tape contains the following files:

5- BDS.XFER.INSTJCL.UNLOAD	Sample JCL
6- BDS.XFER.PROCLIB.UNLOAD	Procedures
7- BDS.XFER.DATALIB.UNLOAD	User Data and Exit Program Source
8- BDS.XFER.RUNLIB.UNLOAD	Programs and Load Modules

The above tape files must be loaded into the following PDS's:

- **5** (Your Choice)
- **6** BDS.XFER.PROCLIB
- 7- BDS.XFER.DATALIB
- 8- BDS.XFER.RUNLIB

User data such as your password and valid LU's is contained in **BDS.XFER.DATALIB**. You should only load the following members in **BDS.XFER.DATALIB**. Otherwise data loss will occur:

XFEXIT01 thru XFEXIT07 XFEX01C thru XFEX07C

The contents of **BDS.XFER.PROCLIB** and **BDS.XFER.RUNLIB** can be completely replaced by the tape files.

- 2. Stop all tasks sending output into this system. This update will take approximately 10 minutes.
- 3. Edit the member BRSCTRL in PDS BDS.XFER.DATALIB. Change positions 2 thru 9 to reflect the current software level indicated above.
- 4. If you have assembled the following programs, you must reassemble them into **BDS.XFER.RUNLIB**:

XFEXIT01 thru XFEXIT07 XFEX01C thru XFEX07C BRS370 (Must be linked as reusable) BXFOPTS (Must be linked as reusable)

FileXfer/MVS is now updated to the new release.
